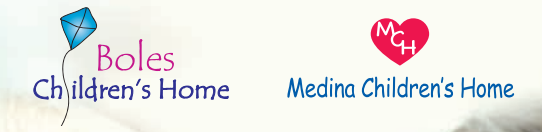

Arms of Hope

Boles Children's Home (est. 1924) and Medina Children's Home (est. 1958) were originally established as Christian homes for orphans, but have grown with innovative programs designed to serve at-risk children and single-mother families. Because they had identical missions and programs, both homes consolidated to form Arms of Hope to achieve efficiency, geographic diversity, increased capacity and additional program improvements and offerings. With a talented management team and large campuses in Medina and Quinlan, Texas, Arms of Hope is a leading residential assistance program for disadvantaged children and families.

PROGRAMS

Together Program

Helps motivated single mothers and their children transition into successful, independent futures by providing parenting skills, career training and a home in a peaceful and safe environment.

Right Start

Makes life a real choice by helping expectant single mothers prepare for motherhood while providing shelter, necessities and skills needed to care for their newborn babies.

Jillian and her daughter (pictured left) entered the Together Program to escape homelessness and to pursue a better life. During her stay, Jillian completed a degree in Elementary Education and is currently a successful teacher. Jillian now has the ability to independently provide Laya with a happy and stable home. "Arms of Hope provided my family a new beginning and helped me become a successful mother," Jillian proudly exclaims.



Residential Child Care

Meets disadvantaged children's physical, emotional, educational and spiritual needs in a warm family-like atmosphere where house-parents function as mother and father figures.

Outreach Ministry

Provides assistance to underprivileged youth in their own neighborhoods. Programs for at-risk children include youth events featuring inspirational speakers and the sponsorship of Christian based youth sports teams.

Emergency Shelter & Assessment Center

Provides emergency shelter and assessment services for any child that has been removed from an abusive environment or is in crisis.

College and Career Program

Provides assistance for Arms of Hope high school graduates with support through college, trade school or into their first job and sometimes includes accommodations for graduates who have not yet found a place to call home.
